

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The color of the edging of the hood indicates the subject of degree (e.g., white for arts, tan for business, light blue for education, pink for music, gold for science, scarlet for theology), and the colors of the lining of the hood indicate the school from which the degree was received. Dark blue, or “Ph.D. blue,” is reserved exclusively for the Doctor of Philosophy degree. The Ph.D. is the highest academic degree that can be earned and represents a rigorous and extensive program resulting in breadth and depth of knowledge and expertise in a discipline. The doctor’s degree is further distinguished by the panels on the sides of the hood, the gold tassel on the cap, and the velvet trim on the gown.
